Event Terms & Conditions

The following 'Terms' govern entry to **WOMAD Glasgow 2026 (the 'Event')** and should be read in accordance with Glasgow Life Ticket Purchase Policy and any relevant venue or licence terms copies of which are available upon written request from Glasgow Life. These Event Terms & Conditions and any ticketing, venue or licensing terms are collectively known as 'Conditions'.

By purchasing or possessing a ticket, you agree to be bound by these conditions and to follow all applicable laws and regulations governing the Event.

Conditions of Entry:

1. A valid ticket is required to be admitted to the Event. Please check your ticket upon receipt as mistakes cannot always be rectified after purchase.
2. Failure to follow the conditions or behaving in a manner deemed anti-social or potentially dangerous in or around the Event, will result in you being refused entry or removed from the Event without refund.
3. Glasgow Life reserve the right to implement restrictions/conditions before and during the Event to ensure it is safe, including any COVID-19 (or any variant) government guidance. You must comply with any such restriction/conditions and any instructions given to you by Event staff and stewards and you may be refused entry or evicted without a refund if you fail to comply.
4. Glasgow Life shall be entitled to cancel the Event at any time and the refund policy set out in the Ticket Purchase Policy shall apply.
5. Glasgow Life reserves the right to change the line-up, programme and/or playing schedule without notice.
6. WOMAD Glasgow is subject to licence.
7. **The event is open to all age groups.**
8. Persons under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a responsible adult over 21 years of age – 1 adult per max 4 under 18s. Please be prepared to provide proof of age.
9. A limited number of tickets are available and free of charge for children under 5 years of age. These must be purchased in advance and are not available on the day.
10. It is your responsibility to check that you and your guests are permitted to attend the Event and have the appropriate Ticket(s) purchased from official ticket outlets for the Event.
11. Your ticket is valid for the date specified on your ticket. Once you exit the Event, you are **not permitted to re-enter on the same day**. Last entry is 8.30pm.

Exception for families:

If you are attending with a child aged **0-4** (with a valid 0-4 ticket), you **may leave and re-enter the festival** before 8.30pm.

After **8.30pm**, **no re-entry** will be permitted for any ticket type, including families with 0-4 tickets.

12. Mobile tickets will be used at this Event. It is your responsibility to ensure your mobile device is charged and you have downloaded your ticket onto the Glasgow Life ticket app in advance of arriving at the Event. Your mobile ticket will be scanned at the entrance and you may be asked to show the ticket again throughout the Event.
13. Glasgow Life is not responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged tickets.
14. Searches are a condition of entry or any part of the Event.
15. Event stewards will conduct bag searches at entrances which may include use of scanners or hand-held wands and prohibited items will be confiscated and not returned, replaced or reimbursed.
16. Event staff and management reserve the right to refuse entry or remove you from the Event for any reason including, but not limited to, concerns regarding the consumption of alcohol and drugs.
17. WOMAD Glasgow is a non-camping event and camping anywhere inside or around the Event is not permitted.
18. Strobe and lighting effects will be in use
19. CCTV will be in operation in the Event and surrounding areas.
20. In entering the Event site you consent to the recording and use of its image and/or voice (“Likeness”) for the purposes of worldwide commercial exploitation of its Likeness by Glasgow Life and WOMAD UK or any entity authorised by Glasgow Life, in any form. The recording of your Likeness may be undertaken using a variety of methods, including by television cameras videography and photography. 21. Glasgow Life does not accept responsibility for any loss or damage to property.
22. Any found property will be passed to Police Scotland after the event.

Prohibited items & Restrictions

23. You are prohibited from bringing any; Glass (including perfume or empty refillable bottles), umbrellas, tents, gazebos or pop-up shades, high back chairs, animals (except registered assistance animals), BBQs, candles, flagpoles, alcohol, illegal substances, single use vapes, pyrotechnics, fireworks, lanterns, flares or smoke devices, knives, weapons or lasers, professional cameras (anything with a detachable lens), drones
24. Bags or Rucksacks larger than an A3 piece of paper are not permitted
25. Any flags, banners or signs of any unauthorised promotional, commercial, political, religious or offensive nature are not permitted.
26. For safety reasons, picnic blankets and low back folding chairs or camping stools are permitted on the condition that they are only used at the outer edges of the audience areas at stages, or as instructed by Event staff.

27. Food/snacks and/or drinks are not permitted and will be confiscated on entry. If you have a medical condition which requires a specific food into the Event, please contact womadglasgow@glasgowlife.org.uk in advance of the event to obtain a letter of authorisation.
28. EMPTY refillable water bottles are permitted to use at the drinking water points.
29. No trading of any item permitted on site except by Event authorised traders.
30. Traders, merchandise and bars will accept cash and card. Please note there are no ATMs at the Event.
